Candidates interested in broad areas of Chinese foreign policy, China's economic policy, (domestic and external), trade, domestic politics, defence policy, urban studies and social movements in China are encouraged to apply.

Specific domains include but are not restricted to the following areas:

Sino-Indian relations, Cross-Strait ties, Democratization and economic development in Taiwan, Regionalism (BRICS, ASEAN, ASEAN+ Framework), China's Nuclear and Defence Modernization, Public Discourse in China, Social movements in China, Political Transitions in China, Minorities in China, Nationalism in China, Trans-national small firm traders linking India, South East Asia, and China Urban Land, Poverty, and Governance issues in China, Small firm cluster industrialization in Greater China area.
