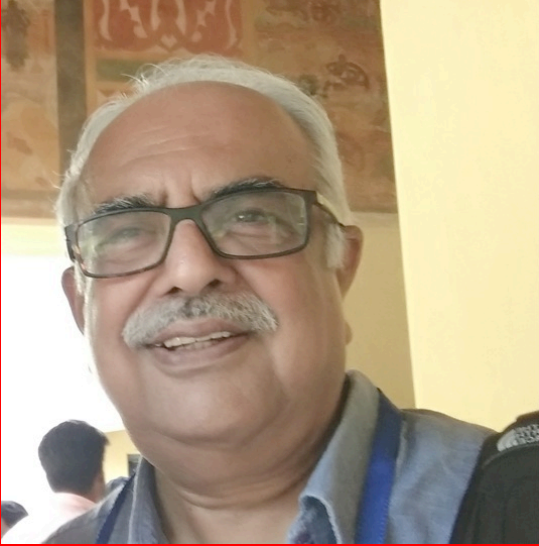

## **PH.D WORKSHOP; 5TH NOVEMBER 11-1 PM: Writing of History: 'Dilemma and Predicaments of Chinese Nationalism and the Agenda for Modernity'**

It cannot be denied that in building the modern nation-state in the framework of myriad emerging ideologies in late nineteenth and early twentieth century Asia, nationalism with its agenda of modernity and progress remained present in the one or another form in the concerns of intellectuals and modernizers in China. Dilemmas and predicaments of west-inspired nationalism highlighted the intellectual, political and cultural discourses of the May Fourth Movement of 1919 and the quest for modernity and progress since then. The workshop explicates alternative modernities presented by Kang Youwei and Zhou Zuoren in late 19th and early twentieth century and its contemporary revival in contemporary China.
